

If you are unable to attend the annual meeting, I will send out a notice later in the month to you as a reminder.



Fishing reports:


On November 25, 2024, Michael Kidd reported on his recent fishing adventure - Fishing has been good on Taneycomo and also Little Piney using wispy.

Rod Pennington provided the following: 31" in carp 6wt 8lb tippet. 16 1/2" white bass.– Stockton Lake





Kim Schultz's fishing report: Kim's recent trip to Michigan



My brother (Kirk) and I had an opportunity to fish for steelhead trout. We fished the Pere Marquette River and



the surf near Ludington. The river was down a bit and clear. Kirk was able to find and hook several



steelhead going two for three on the first day. I found several rainbow trout under sixteen inches. The next day, we started at

Butterfield Park south on the Ludington piers. We fished five hours hooking up nine fish and landing four. The steelhead were under 7 lbs. The wind was forecasted to blow more than 15 MPR, which is too much wind and wave action to fish the surf. So, we stopped to get a bit to eat and returned to the Pere Marquette to fish. My bother again caught steelhead going four for six. I caught more short trout and finally hooked and landed a King Salmon. We fished until 5 PM. We considered staying another night, but the NE winds were forecasted to drop 4-inches of snow. It was a short trip, with success catching large fish. Christian Andrews provided the below information regarding members who would like to donate flies or tie these at the monthly fly tying sessions

By way of clarification:

The club fly tying nights for the remainder of 2024 are July 25, August 22, September 26, and October 24. Dennis Stead will be the lead on July 25. Cecil Woodman will be teaching the Mayfly Cripple on August 22. Who will volunteer to demonstrate for the September and October sessions?

Additionally, we will be doing open fly tying from 5:30 to 7 pm before the first Thursday meetings. Christian Andrews has challenged the members to tie flies for <u>https://www.tieathon.org/</u>. He will award one of his handcrafted bobbins to the member who contributes the most 100 fly batches by March 31, 2025.
