The club fly tying nights for the remainder of 2024 are September 26, and October 24. No flytying on November 28—Thanksgiving.

September 26—Christian Andrews will be tying the Comparadun and Sparkledun; on October 24 Dennis Stead will be tying the Mighty Mite

Here are the recipes for the September 26 meeting:

Comparadun Hook: dry #10 - 20 Thread: to match body - strong enough to die in deer hair Wing: Hollow mottled deer hair Tail: blue dun hackle fibers (or fibits) Body: antron (or dry fly) dubbing, color match the hatch

Sparkle Dun Hook: dry #10 - 20 (recipe in Kaufmann's Tying Dry Flies says #16 - 20) Thread: yellow - strong enough to tie in deer hair Wing: hollow gray deer hair Tail: olive brown Z-Lon (or comparable synthetic) Body: yellowins poly dubbing




